- OneCare achieved 100% of shared savings if available. 23 our of 26 possible points = 88% or 100% quality score.

Commercial Quality Measure Performance

- For Year 3, 9 measures were performance measures. The remaining measures were for reporting only.
- 10 CAHPS measures were collected but are for reporting only.
- All measure are shown as adherence rates (Number Met/Number Sampled) except for Core 10 and Core 12 which are measured per 100,000 Population and survey results which are percentages.
- Core Measure 12 was awarded points based on change over time because there is no national benchmark. The measure was eligible for a maximum of 2 points rather than 3 points because Year 2 rates were statistically no different than zero, so the improvement from Year 2 to Year 3 that would be needed to attain 3 points was not possible.
