- COPD is the 3rd leading cause of death in the United States
- COPD accounts for 1.5 million emergency room visits annually
- Approximately two-thirds of patients in the emergency department with COPD symptoms are consequently admitted as inpatients
- 1 in 13 people have asthma
- Asthma accounts for 11 million doctor's office visits, 439,435 discharges from hospital inpatient care and 1.7 million emergency department visits each year
- Asthma is the third-ranking cause of hospitalization among children younger than 15
