

Total Cost of Care by Payment Type

This graph with vertical bars shows the total cost of care by payment type over time. The X-axis is labelled as “years” and includes 2018, 2019, and 2020. The Y-axis is labeled as “dollars” and ranges from \$100 million to \$1 billion in increments of \$100 million.

Total cost of care was lowest in 2018 and increased steadily through the years 2019 and 2020 from around \$550 million in 2018 to almost 1 billion in 2020.

Each bar is broken out into FPP non-reconciled in green, FPP reconciled in purple, and FFS accountability in blue. FFS accountability represents the largest percentage of the total cost of care for all three years. FFP reconciled and FFP non-reconciled together steadily become a larger percentage of the total cost of care in 2018 (~40%) and 2019 (~44%), but are a smaller percentage of the total cost of care in 2020 (~36%).
